Financials and Envelopes Reports

Rita reported that the pledges for the year are over budget. To date there are a total of 24 pledge cards in, last year the total was 18, approximately \$43,000.00 has been pledged for the general fund.

Stewardship Report

It was agreed that the Stewardship campaign was very successful. A big thank you to Rita and Don for leading the campaign. It was suggested that the wording for the pledge form be reviewed, it was also agreed that the it was very helpful that the bulletin back page reflections were stewardship focused. There was conversation about either a spring or Easter fundraising event. Karen volunteered to organize it.

Maintenance Report

Trevor reported that the roof leak has been fixed thanks to the storm blowing off a piece of flashing.

The front and side doors have been resealed and are now draft free. There were some lose wires in the furnace, they have been corrected. Trevor has arranged for snow removal.

The meeting room has been painted, thanks Trevor and Ulreke for doing this. Cameron is working with the user groups so that the closet is used for storage not the room.

Trevor has replaced many light fixtures.

There is a new couch coming for the narthex area, it is a gift from a member. It was noted to add 'flooring' to the January agenda.

In the new year we will work on redoing the nursery room

It was noted that the tree behind the cross is in need of attention, Eve and Rita will look after it.

We seem to be having some issues with the newsletter being sent from the website, Trevor is working on this.

Facebook page is up and running, we are looking into how to increase our exposure, possibly by placing some ads on facebook.
